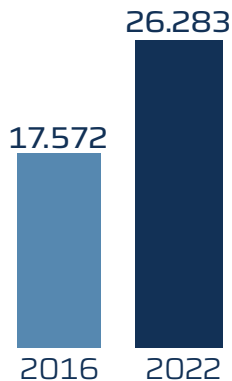

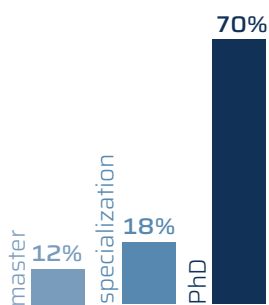

We have an active internationalization policy, as evidenced by our many bilateral and multilateral agreements and the various international academic and scientific cooperation projects in force.

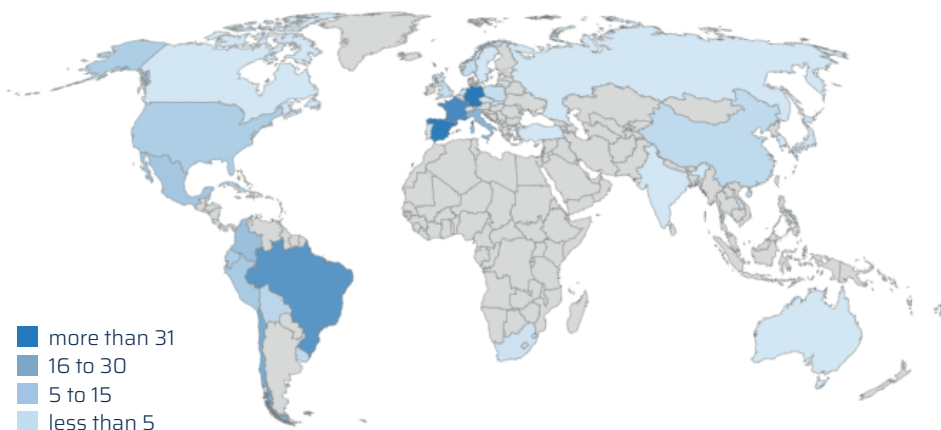
